This will be so we can donate to the "Ava Roy Fund". Ava is the 9-year-old daughter of single parent and Worcester Firefighter Christopher Roy, age 36. Firefighter Roy died in the line of duty in the early morning of Dec. 9, 2018 while battling a 5- alarm fire. After this, the ride will continue and end at the Red Nights Memorial. When we arrive, we will be taking a picture with all that attended the ride and many of our Founding Fathers. This picture will be blown up, framed and donated to the Red Knights Memorial Hall where we hope it will remain for many years to come. This will be a self ride back to the hotel.
